In Thailand, Thompson started a silk business. He worked with traditional Thai silk, and he worked to help artists who produced traditional Thai crafts.
He became very successful. He built a huge house in Bangkok in the traditional Thai style. In it, he had an extremely valuable collection of rare Thai art. Today, it's one of the most interesting museums in Bangkok.
In 1967, when he was 61 years old, Thompson went on vacation in a rainforest area in Malaysia called the Cameron Highlands. One Sunday afternoon, he went out for a walk—and disappeared. He was never seen again.
Thompson was a heavy smoker, but he was in good health. When he disappeared, he left his cigarettes and lighter behind.
The police searched for several weeks, but they never found his body or any of his possessions. The search was very difficult because it was a dense forest with no roads. Wild animals such as tigers lived there.
Six months after Thompson disappeared, his sister was murdered in her home in Chicago. The police said the crime was committed by burglars.
To this day, no one knows what happened to Jim Thompson.
