




Crow glides through the hills. He has not had water in a long time. He must have water!




Then Crow spots a pitcher and dives down to check. It has a bit of water inside.

Crow gets one more stone and drops it in. Then he gets one more. Time after time, Crow drops in stones.




Before long, the water in the pitcher rises. It rises up and up. Crow stops and admires his trick.
