


One way to save water is to put up a dam. A dam will hold back a river.




Or the water from such a lake can be sent to a city. Then people will have water for drinking, washing, and other uses.




One way to stop flooding is to put up a dike. A dike will hold back the sea or a lake. This stops water from flooding the land at the back of the dike.




A lock can help boats use a river in which the water level shifts up and down.
