

There are many types of context clues to look for when you do not know a word's meaning.

- A definition is the most direct kind of context clue. It sometimes appears right after an unknown word, telling you what the word means.
- You can sometimes find an explanation near the unknown word.
- There may be one or more words that serve as examples of the unfamiliar word.
- You may find a synonym, or a word with nearly the same meaning, in the same sentence as the unknown word.
- You may also find a clue in an antonym, a word that is opposite in meaning to the unfamiliar word. An antonym is a contrast to the meaning of the unknown word.
- A restatement, which is a different way of expressing a word's meaning, is similar to a synonym.

Often, though, context clues are not all in one place, so you may have to make an inference about a word's meaning based on more than just a word or two. You may have to consider the whole sentence or even an entire paragraph in order to add up all the clues to meaning.

| Type of Context Clue | How It Works | Example |
|----------------------|---|--|
| Definition | defines the word directly in the text | If you are <i>successful</i> , you <u>achieve</u> your goal. |
| Explanation | explains the word directly in the text | When you are <i>successful</i> , or <u>have done something well</u> , you feel good. |
| Example | a particular instance or case | I felt <i>successful</i> after <u>getting a high grade on the test</u> . |
| Synonym | a word or phrase that means almost the same thing | The <i>successful</i> student was <u>doing well</u> . |
| Antonym | a word or phrase that means almost the opposite | The <i>successful</i> student was still afraid of <u>failing</u> . |
| Restatement | a different way of expressing a word's meaning | Original statement: I was <i>successful</i> with my homework deadline. Restatement: I finished my homework on time. |
| Inference | uses text and background knowledge to infer meaning | The student celebrated after a <i>successful</i> school year. |
