Presentation

Affirmative

I/You/We/You/They	like	music.
He/She/It	likes	animals. sport.

Negative

I/You/We/You/They	don't like	music.
He/She/It	doesn't like	animals. sport.

TIP *don't = do not* *doesn't = does not*

Yes/No questions

Do	I/you/we/you/they	like	music?
Does	he/she/it		sport?

Short answers

Yes,	I/you/we/you/they	do.
	he/she/it	does.
No,	I/you/we/you/they	don't.
	he/she/it	doesn't.
